



## Private Swimming Instruction at Lakeshore Athletic Club

All Lakeshore swimming instructors teach classes scheduled weekly in the club's curriculum. This way you can be insured of a teacher who is up-to-date in their teaching methods and able to help you jump start your swimming program. One-on-one instruction allows you to learn the skills of swimming at your own pace; making sure you do not skip a step. Proper alignment and breathing technique are fundamental to the sport of swimming. Learn the basics at your own pace.

Meeting times are agreed upon between the teacher and student. Private instruction may not coincide with any of the group classes offered at Lakeshore. (We want to provide ample lap swimming lanes for the members.)

**Member Lesson Charges:** (\*Non-members may purchase lessons at a 25% premium)

<b>Private:</b>	1 lesson @ \$35	3 lessons @ \$90	5 lessons @ \$150
<b>Semi-Private:</b>	1 lesson @ \$45	3 lessons @ \$112.50	5 lessons @ \$187.50

### How to pay for your private/ semi-private swimming lessons:

- Start at the front desk. The lesson charges are found under Swim Lesson, Private
- You will be paying for one, three or five lessons.
- The front desk attendant must give you a voucher each time you take a lesson.
- If you have purchased more than one lesson, your voucher will be stored in an electronic Lakeshore account.
- Make sure that the service you have purchased and your instructor's name appear on your voucher.
- As always, keep a copy of your receipts for lesson history.
- Lessons expire after 6 months, and there are no refunds.

### Lesson procedures:

- A 24 hour cancellation notice is customary.
- No-show on the part of the student is charged at the full rate.
- No show on the part of the coach means the patron will receive a complimentary lesson.
- Please be on time. Due to tardiness, a lesson might not be the full ½ hour.
- Students will come to the lesson dressed appropriately in competitive swimming attire. This includes, at a minimum, suit and goggles.

### How to arrange a private swimming lesson:
